REQUIREMENTS

- UNCG GPA of 3.30 or higher at graduation
- At least 12 s.h. of Honors course work with grades of at least B (3.0):
 - 6-9 s.h. Honors course work in major
 - HSS 490: Senior Honors Project (3 s.h.)
 - 0-3 s.h. of other Honors course work

RECOGNITION

Receive a Certificate of Disciplinary Honors and have that accomplishment, along with the title of your Senior Honors Project, noted on your official transcript; and be recognized at a banquet held at the end of the spring semester.
