The scholarship provides a \$1,250, per semester, merit scholarship to a fulltime undergraduate African American and African Diaspora Studies major, in good standing, with exemplary academic performance in the African American and African Diaspora Studies Program. Awards are made on the basis of past academic performance, a 250 word essay that explains what inspired the applicant to choose African American and African Diaspora Studies as a major; describes the impact the African American and African Diaspora Studies Program has had on the applicant’s education, and outlines the applicant’s future academic plans. A letter of recommendation from a UNCG faculty member, staff member, or advisor familiar with your academic performance is also required. Please note: *Applications will be processed through the financial aid office. If you are already a recipient of financial aid, the award may impact your total UNCG compensation package. The Ransome Scholar will be chosen by a committee and the recipients will be contacted by email in December.*
