

**Call for Abstracts, due December 10, 2019**

The African American and African Diaspora Studies Program at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro (UNCG) invites abstract and panel proposal submissions for its 2020 Annual Conference on African American & African Diasporic Cultures & Experience (CACE).

The theme for this year's conference is "Connections and Collaborations Across Disciplines and Communities." This conference theme will focus on overcoming boundaries, creating connections and increasing collaboration both across disciplinary backgrounds as well as local and global Black communities. The theme is intended to inspire passionate discussion of real, imagined, and artificial segregations both within and outside of academia. It is also intended as a call for socio-political and academic activism, through which we imagine a path for a resilient, inter-disciplinary, and collaborative future for Black communities and their allies.

We seek paper abstracts, panel proposals and poster presentations which broadly address Black communities and the conference theme. Presentations from undergraduate and graduate students, faculty and friends of the community are all welcome. Collaborative presentations between students and faculty are particularly encouraged. We also invite students and groups to participate in the spoken word presentation for the **Literary Café**, a space to celebrate creativity.
